Ces parcours sont optionnels : ils s'ajoutent aux 51 heures de formation par quinzaine et se déroulent sur un ou deux mercredis après-midi banalisés.

CLIL-Methodology & ICT Tools for Teachers working with CLIL

★★★★★

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This course introduces you to the principles of CLIL (Content and Language Integrated Learning) and analyses CLIL teaching techniques, including ways of integrating ICT into a CLIL classroom teaching environment.

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During this practical course, online software tools suitable for CLIL, and teaching aids specifically designed for the use of CLIL will be introduced and reviewed.

Our CLIL courses are designed for non-native teachers (in the primary, secondary and vocational sectors) who teach other subjects, such as Geography, Mathematics, Science etc in English. This course is also ideal for those teachers who are about to start using CLIL to teach a subject in English, and would like to use technology as a teaching aid for CLIL in their lessons.

The main aim of this course is to explore the dimensions and approach of CLIL teaching as well as to introduce you to practical online software tools and teaching aids suitable for using CLIL (Content and Language Integrated Learning) in the classroom. This two-week (over 10 training days) course allows you to develop a better understanding of CLIL methodology as well as develop your ICT skills for the CLIL classroom. Topics such as building a CLIL store unit, exploring cognition and what it entails, thinking about scaffolding for learners and other important topics relevant to the CLIL classroom will be presented, reviewed and discussed.

You will have ample opportunity to try out all of these tools as all our courses are designed to be hands-on and practical.

You will be encouraged to take an active role in all sessions, maximising your use of English, and collaborating together with your fellow trainees to create your own resources.

During our group discussions you will have the opportunity to share CLIL activities that you have created as well as to provide feedback to each other.

You will be asked to reflect upon the training received and you will come up with a Personal Development Action Plan, selecting tools and activities you would like to try out in your own classes.

During this course, you will have opportunities to:

- acquire a greater understanding of the principles underlying CLIL methodology
- become better equipped to integrate CLIL principles and methodology in your everyday lessons
- develop a better understanding of ways to integrate ICT into a CLIL classroom teaching environment
- develop your skills in designing dual-purpose learning materials
- be introduced to practical online software tools suitable for CLIL and teaching aids specifically designed for the use of CLIL
- gain the skills to use such applications to create your own teaching materials
- improve your command of English in a multi-cultural context.

CLIL For Primary, Secondary and Vocational School Teachers

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Our 1 & 2 week CLIL courses are for both individual teachers and closed groups. The course is needs driven and the content is negotiated with the participants.

The aim of the course is to give participants a comprehensive overview of the CLIL methodology demonstrating its potential and to provide participants with a variety of practical classroom activities and materials.

Day-by-day timetable

Day 1: Introduction to CLIL- setting the context

Morning:

- *Needs analysis
- *Defining CLIL
- *Variety in educational settings and contexts in CLIL. Sharing experiences- CLIL contexts in participants' countries/schools.

Afternoon:

- *History and the underlying principles of CLIL
- *Qualities in skills required by teachers involved in CLIL
- *Motivating learners and teachers through CLIL

Day 2: Lesson Planning and the Four Dimensional CLIL Framework

Morning:

- *How to plan lessons using a CLIL approach. What do we need to consider when planning and delivering CLIL lessons
- *Integrating the 4Cs framework into CLIL activities
- *Developing Thinking Skills- HOTS, LOTS and the use of questions
- *Teaching objectives & learning outcomes and how they are related to subject and language

Afternoon

- *Workshop- Planning lessons and developing materials within the framework of the 4Cs

Day 3: How to CLIL- Integrating Language and Content & The Selection and Adaptation of Materials in CLIL

Morning:

- *Language challenges in the classroom. The relationship between language and cognition- Content and Language Cognitive Demand (CCD & LCD)
- *Features of language to consider when teaching CLIL: BICS and CALP, Content-compatible and content-obligatory language
- *Language for managing the classroom and language for teaching subject content
- *Subject-centred vocabulary building. Methodology for presenting vocabulary
- *Tools for working with content- visual organisers and multimedia

Afternoon:

- *Identifying the 4Cs in CLIL materials and using the framework to analyse your materials
- *Subject-led and language-led materials approach- the purpose and different features
- *Strategies for adapting listening and reading texts for use in CLIL

- *Workshop- Key issues of materials in CLIL- evaluate, adapt and create materials for teaching your subjects in English
